

STRATEGY NAME

Brief introduction to the strategy and its evidence of effectiveness.

OVERVIEW

Description: Describes the strategy, including critical components, examples of strategy variations, and other factors often accompanying strategy implementation.

SEM Level: Specifies the level(s) of the socio-ecological model for which the evidence supports this strategy: Individual-Level Behavior Change, Interpersonal Relationships, Organizational Policies or Practices, Community Environments, and/or Social Norms.

Targeted Outcomes: Provides a list of the strategy's intended outcomes, including capacity and area of improvement.

Settings: Identifies the specific settings in which the intervention has been evaluated.

EXAMPLES

Provides examples of evaluated strategy variations.

EVIDENCE

Summarizes existing reviews of the evidence related to the effectiveness of the strategy in producing targeted outcomes for specified settings.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

Limitations: Includes insights on the primary barriers or challenges to strategy use. Examples include resource requirements, evaluation limitations, etc.

Recommendations: Provides tips on processes and practices that enhance or support the success of the strategy. Examples include adapting and coordinating components of the strategy, building coalitions, etc.

RESOURCES

Online version provides descriptions with links to web-based resources helpful for the development and implementation of the strategy.
